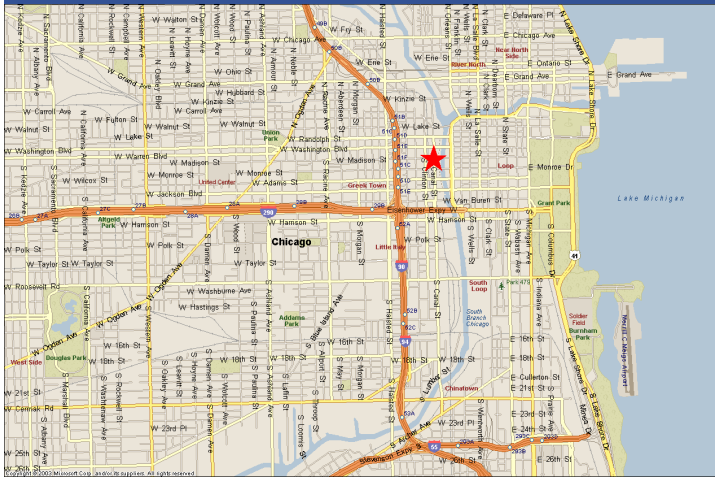

ALERT SUMMARY: CHICAGO HOSTAGE SITUATION

DATE

December 8, 2006

TIME

3:15 PM CST

500 W Madison St

INCIDENT SITUATION

Three people were shot and killed by a gunman in the Citigroup Center office building on the afternoon of December 8. The gunman, 59 year old Joe Jackson, entered the building armed with a revolver and knife and forced a guard to take him to the 38th floor law offices of Wood Philips. Once there, Jackson shot and killed three others before a SWAT team sniper shot and killed him. The Ogilvie Transportation Center, which is in the same building, was closed temporarily and Metra and Union Pacific train lines were suspended during the incident. Police ordered office workers to lock their doors and remain inside while they searched and cleared the building.

NC4 COVERAGE

NC4 provides ongoing updates to members as the incident unfolds through the National Incident Monitoring Center (NIMC). NIMC analysts follow the incident using official government sources as well as national and international media sources. In following the story, we used media coverage such as the ABC7 breaking news article "Apparent hostage situation at Ogilvie Transit Center," and Metra Service Rail updates, as well as government confirmed updates from the Chicago Police Department and a live video feed to NBC5 coverage in Chicago was linked. NC4 also provided information to members about the law firm involved in the shooting before any other media outlets.

Synopsis: W Madison St & N Canal St - Ogilvie Station closed due to hostage situation, shots fired.
Police are on the scene of a hostage situation at the Citibank building at 500 W Madison St at N Canal St. Shootings have reportedly taken place on the 1st, 2nd, and 38th floors. At least two people have been confirmed injured, one person has reportedly been killed. Ogilvie Station is reportedly closed until further notice. The hostage taker reportedly had one person at gunpoint. Authorities are asking people to stay inside their offices.
